According to our suppliers, and to the best of our knowledge, the raw materials and manufacturing processes used in the product lines do not possess levels beyond acceptable limits, as identified in the RoHS regulation, of the following:

- Cadmium
- Lead
- Mercury
- Hexavalent chromium
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB)
- Polybrominated dipheyl ethers (PBDE)
- Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP)
- Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)
